PURPOSE:

The Paul Szymanski Spirit Award was created to recognize Paul Szymanski for his many years of service to the Toledo Junior Golf Association (TJGA), not only as a board member but for his past leadership as President. This honor recognizes the boy or girl who may have overcome or dealt with an obstacle in their life, yet embodies the love of life and the game of golf as Paul Szymanski did for so many years. The applicant must be an incoming high school senior (in Fall 2011) or graduating high school senior and a current member of the TJGA. The recipient of the award will receive a \$1,000 one-time, non-renewable scholarship which will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution of the student's choice for the purposes of covering education-related expenses such as tuition, books, on-campus room and board, and related fees.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY:

1. U.S. citizen;
2. Current member of the TJGA;
3. Planning to enroll at an accredited two or four year post-secondary institution (including colleges or universities, technical colleges or trade schools) to start in Fall 2011 or 2012;
4. Active participant in at least eight (8) TJGA-sanctioned events;
5. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) at the time of application.

BASIS FOR SELECTION:

The Award recipient will be chosen by the Paul Szymanski Spirit Award Selection Committee, which will consider the qualifications noted above and information submitted on the scholarship application form and all attachments (as noted below). Personal interviews may be required at the discretion of the Scholarship Advisory Committee.
